

## ***Mayor's Advisory Commission for Citizens w/ Disabilities***

**Number of Members:** 14    **Term of Length:** Staggered 3 year terms

**Established by** Executive Order S-11-10

**Meeting Date/Time/Place:** *Has 11 monthly meetings annually; no meeting in December. Meets the last Monday of each month, 3p.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the Legislative Chamber of the Douglas/Omaha Civic Center, 1819 Farnam, Omaha*

**Appointment Process:** *Appointed by Mayor. Commission shall have an Executive Committee composed of a Chairperson appointed by the Mayor and a Vice-Chairperson and Secretary elected annually by members of the commission.*

**Special Qualifications:** *Composed of 14 members representing the broad cross-section of the Omaha Community w/ physical, visual, hearing or other disabilities*

**Residency Requirements:** *Mayor requires City of Omaha residency a prerequisite for membership with the exception of the Commission's secretary position.*

**Responsible Department:** Mayor's office

**Payment:** None specified

**Summary of Duties:** *The commission is to counsel and advise the Mayor of concerns of citizens with disabilities and recommend to the Mayor policies to be implemented through municipal government that: affect the status of citizens with disabilities; affect employment in municipal government of citizens with disabilities; and affect accessibility to and from public buildings and infrastructures governed by municipal codes and ordinances.*

*The commission shall report quarterly to the Mayor on the progress of its deliberations and produce a written report by March 31 of each year.*
